Worker Liasion

Hello from Linds the Worker Liaison!

Once again our volunteers are absolutely amazing! Thank you all so much for what you do!

July weekend we had a LOT of last minute registrations. I want everyone to know that the gate list does not auto populate from anywhere. I download a report from MSR on Wednesday night and then compile 3 different lists to create the gate list each weekend. We will take volunteers whenever they are able to commit to helping, but if you do not register to volunteer by 8pm on Wednesday before the race weekend, do not count on being on the gate list. If you fail to register by 8pm on Wednesday, you will likely need to pay the gate fee. After volunteering you can request a reimbursement from the Treasurer. This costs the club money, though, when we have to do it this way. We are allotted a certain number of gate entries with our track rental that we use for our volunteers and their guests. When we do not use those included entries, we don't get any reimbursement from the track. We use them or lose them. By not using those gate entries and instead refunding people who register late, the CRA is losing money. This has a trickle down effect that impacts other areas of spending. So please make sure to register to volunteer by 8pm on the Wednesday before the race weekend! If you are unsure whether you have registered or not, send me an email and I'll look it up for you.

Volunteer registration for our Hastings round is open! Everyone who volunteers at our Hastings event will get a one-of-a-kind t-shirt designed specially for this weekend. The Lead of Trophies plays a vital role in celebrating the achievements of CRA racers by coordinating all aspects of trophy planning, ordering, and distribution. This role manages the end-to-end trophy process, from data compilation and vendor coordination to final distribution at the year-end banquet and beyond. The ideal candidate will bring a passion for recognizing excellence, strong organizational skills, and a drive to continuously improve the process.

Trophy Planning & Coordination:

- Collaborate with the Board of Directors and MSR Administrator to confirm ordering structures, podium categories, and recognition criteria.
- Compile race results and podium placements using Speedhive and Time & Scoring reports.
- Create and manage the bulk trophy order with the designated vendor, ensuring accuracy and timeliness.

Trophy Preparation:

- Sort, label, and package trophies for distribution, ensuring each award is matched correctly to its recipient.
- Solicit endurance race photos and create printed plaque inserts for endurance podiums.
- Secure and organize number plates for the Top 10 Novice and Expert riders.

Distribution:

- Coordinate and execute trophy distribution at the annual awards banquet.
- Work with the Board and Race Director to distribute remaining trophies post-banquet as needed.

Ideal Qualities & Requirements:

- A genuine desire to honor and highlight the accomplishments of CRA racers.
- Passion for simplifying and innovating the trophy and recognition process.
- Strong spreadsheet, database, and data interpretation skills.
- High attention to detail with the ability to manage and organize bulk data and physical inventory.
- Comfort working independently with periodic coordination check-ins.

Time Commitment & Nature of Work:

- The majority of the workload occurs during the off-season (October–January) and can be completed in focused, finite work sessions.
- Light touchpoints may occur mid-season for photo or data collection, but the heaviest lift is preparation for the banquet.

Volunteer Incentive Program

The Volunteer Incentive Committee and Board of Directors is implementing a new CRA Volunteer Program!

What this program does:

- Converts to a new system based on hours worked.
- Establishes Min/Max volunteers for each specialty and implements a multiplier within each specialty based on specific roles.
- Updates rewards to a tier/level system based on volunteer roles and hours worked.
- Keeps the existing rewards and rebalances distribution.
- Allows volunteer award choices at each tier/level.
- Adjusts tier/level to the current costs of the reward.
- Adds a Saturday Volunteer dinner (replacing the worker raffle) as both an incentive and community building activity.
- Adds a compliance and enforcement structure/process and identifies the process for reporting and tracking of hours.






